California Code of Regulations
Title 1, Section 100 Changes

Title 16, Division 8

Article 7. Special Provisions

## Repeal Section 872.1 as follows:

§872.1 Checklist for Homeowners.

- (a) As used in this regulation, home improvement is defined in Code Section 7151.2.
- (b) The following statement, must accompany every estimate (bid) intended to result in a home improvement contract and every home improvement contract that does not include a swimming pool. The heading shall be printed in at least 14-point type, the questions in at least 12-point type, and the comments in italics of at least 11-point type. The text should be bold where indicated. This is 14-point type. This is 12-point type in italics.

Pursuant to Bus. & Prof. §7159.3 (SB 2029), hHome improvement contractors must provide this notice.
